



WATER/WASTEWATER OPERATOR/MAINTENANCE SUPERVISOR POSITION

The City of Littlefork is seeking a responsible person for a full time Water/Wastewater Operator/Maintenance Supervisor. The position is responsible for operations and maintenance of streets, storm sewers, parks, buildings, and the water and wastewater systems and facilities.

Required Operator Certifications:

- 1) High school diploma or GED;
- 2) Class C Drinking Water Operator Certificate (preferred) or the ability to obtain a Class C Drinking Water Operator Certificate within 12 months;
- 3) Class D Wastewater Operator Certificate (preferred) or the ability to obtain within 12 months;

Preferred qualifications include three years of experience in public works maintenance including water and wastewater and street maintenance operations, along with a Class C water and a Class D wastewater license. Two years of college or vocational/technical training in water and wastewater operations can substitute for two years of experience. Position requires responding to emergencies after hours and rotating on-call duty evenings, weekends and holidays. Successful applicant must reside within a 15 minute response time from the maintenance shop. Wages are dependent on qualifications. Health Insurance offered & Retirement Plan provided. Applications must be received no later than 4:30p.m. on Tuesday, June 30, 2026.
